

BOARD OF DIRECTOR'S NOMINATION NOTIFICATION

At the 2017 LREA Annual General Meeting there will be three Board vacancies. These Board positions are: Barich (Zone 1) for a 3 year term; Hilliard (Zone 3) for a 3 year term; and Lavoy (Zone 4) for a 3 year term.

NOMINATION PROCESS

According to our by-laws, nominations for the office of Director must be submitted to the Secretary of the Association in the 45 day period between July 15th and August 31st of the Year in question. **Nominations will not be accepted after that date.** A nomination for the position of Director must have the signature of the candidate certifying that he/she is a "member in good standing" and eligible for election. The member making the nomination must also sign the nomination form indicating that he/she is also a "member in good standing".

Nomination forms will be available at the LREA Ltd. office on July 1st of each year, and will also include a package of information regarding the duties and obligations of a Board member. This package of information will include the LREA Business Plan, Strategic Plan, and a copy of the latest independent audit.

When planting trees along or close to power lines, please ensure that they are planted a minimum 8.5m (28 feet) from the line. For species which grow taller than 8.5m or 28 feet, please plant with a horizontal spacing greater than the expected full grown mature height.
