Stable Rate

As of May 1, 2020 the stable rate option will remain at 6.49cents/kWh for a contract term of 1 year.

The RRO for January 2020 was 8.185c/kWh, February 2020 was 8.453c/kWh, March 2020 was 6.794c/kWh and April 2020 is 5.988c/kWh.
