

Harvest

Harvest is right around the corner for most farmers.

Lakeland REA wants to remind you to be safe this harvest season and to watch for overhead powerlines. Be sure you know the location of overhead powerlines and that your equipment can pass under safely.

Exercise caution if equipment is higher than 4.88 meters (16 feet).

During Harvest, farmers must be aware of the increased potential for fatigue/inattentiveness that may increase the possibility of injury when using equipment.

Most accidents and injuries that involve equipment occur while machinery is in operation. Idle machinery can also be dangerous to workers. It is important to take care when doing a pre-harvest inspection, making sure that basic safety checks are in place.
